Quick Wins - Boost Your Score Fast

- In Part B, you missed the article 'the' before 'end of the day' and used 'organise' instead of 'organised'.
- Your Accuracy score of 70 shows grammar errors especially with past tenses are affecting your overall estimate.
- Your Prosody score of 70 is the area with the most room for improvement.

Your Strengths

- In Part B, you repeated the first sentence perfectly — 'The conference was cancelled because of the unexpected storm' — showing strong listening accuracy when sentences are shorter.
- In Part E, you captured the main sequence of the story — Maria received a complaint, checked the system, arranged a visit, and the customer called back. Good overall comprehension of the narrative.
- In Part F, you gave a clear personal opinion with reasons, for example 'I prefer work from home because it is more comfortable and productive for me.' This kind of direct opinion with justification scores well on Versant.

Areas for Improvement

- In Part B, sentence 4, you said 'organise' instead of 'organised'. Tense accuracy in sentence repetition directly affects your Accuracy score.
- In Part C, you said 'the items were damage' instead of 'the items were damaged'. Missing past participle forms like this reduce your Accuracy score. Practise short answer responses in Part C Practice focusing on verb forms.
- In Part E, you said 'in telecom company' instead of 'at a telecommunications company' and missed that the technician 'had already been assigned'. Including these specific details improves your Completeness score.
